PART ONE: We request this information in order to assess vessels and crew for the risk they may present in relation to a range of Commonwealth laws. Under subsection 64ACB(8) of the Customs Act 1901, information relating to crew must be disclosed to the Department of Immigration And Citizenship. This information may also be disclosed to a number of agencies including the Department of Transport and Regional Services, the Australian Federal Police, Australian Crime Commission, Attorney-General's Department and the Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade.

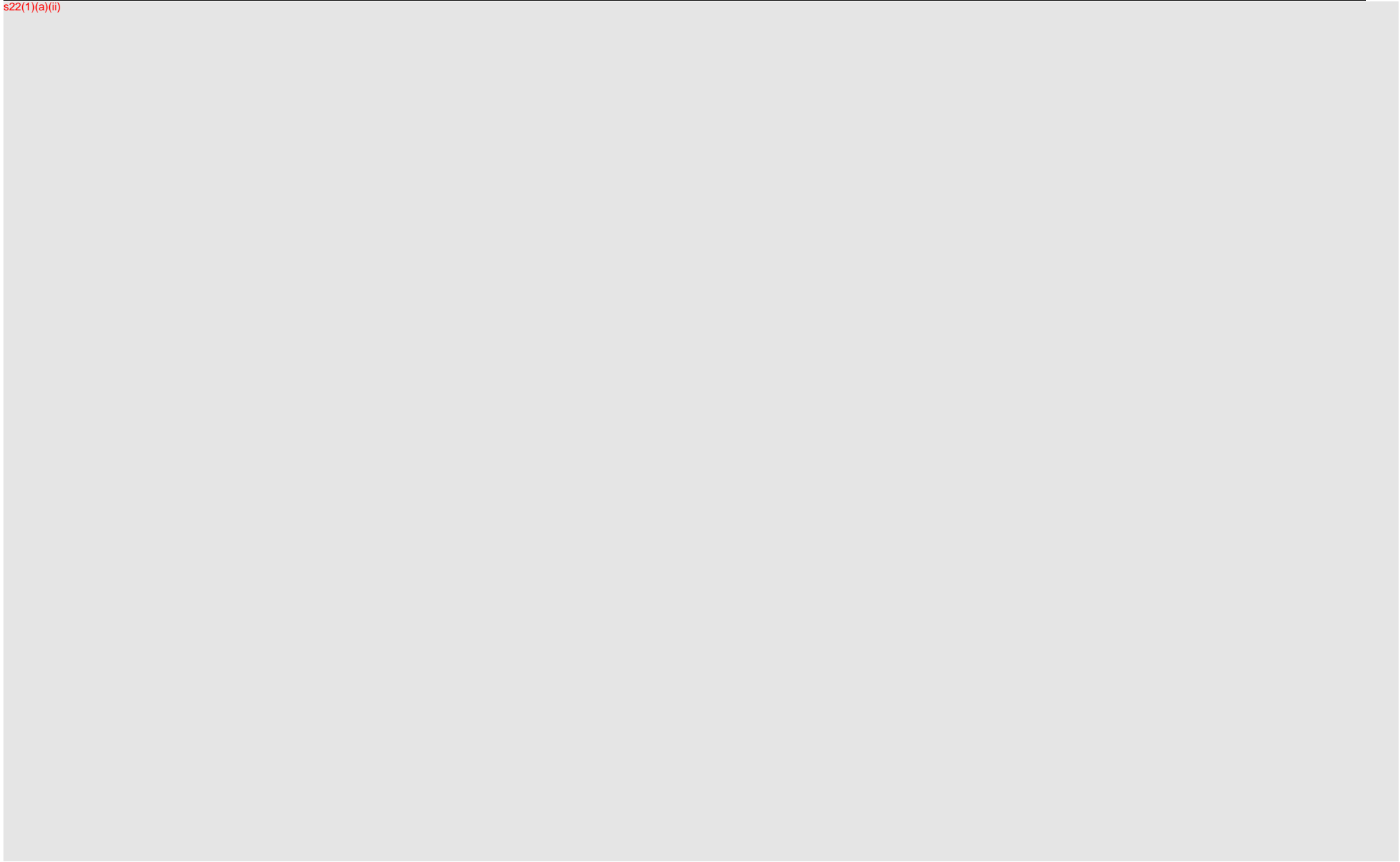
