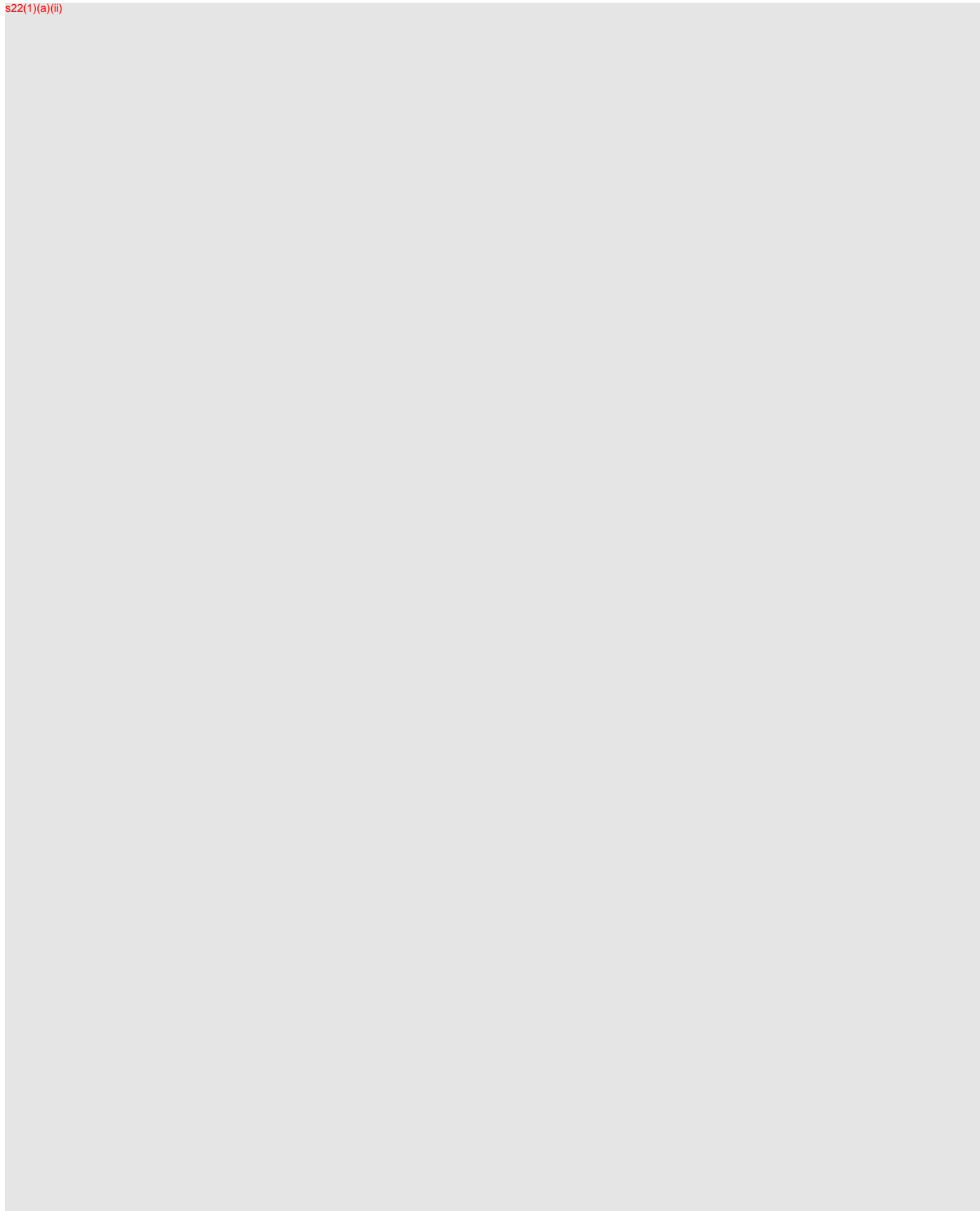

Dear Sir,

I am hereby writing this mail to inform you that on 22nd May 2012, a boat departed from Jakarta (Bogor) towards Christmas Island in which there were 21 asylum seekers and two crew members. But still there is no news from them whether they have reached to Christmas Island or still on the way.

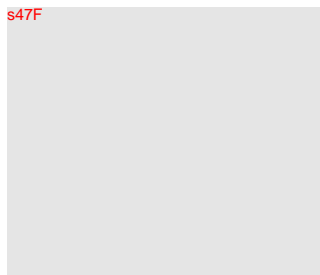
I am regularly checking the news if they have reached to their destiny but still there is no such news about them. Either they have lost their way or they might be in big trouble.

As per my information they left from Bogor towards Christmas Island from the short way which I have heard is of 38 to 40 hours.

Please I beg you all to pay attention on this matter seriously as a human being and kindly start searching for that boat which is missing from 22nd May 2012. Their family members are really very worried about them.

Information:

At approximately 1242hrs this date a male persons called the AOCC to enquire on how to find out about if family and friends have made it to Christmas Island.

I was advised that a vessel departed Indonesia on the 13 August 2012 with 24 pax onboard. The last contact the caller had with the vessel was on the 12 August 2012.

When I asked the caller who he knew on the vessel, I was told that he had a 16 year old cousin on board.

I was told that the vessel was enroute to Christmas Island, and that the pax were of Afghani decent.

Call terminated at 1248hrs
