s33(a)(i) & s47E(d)



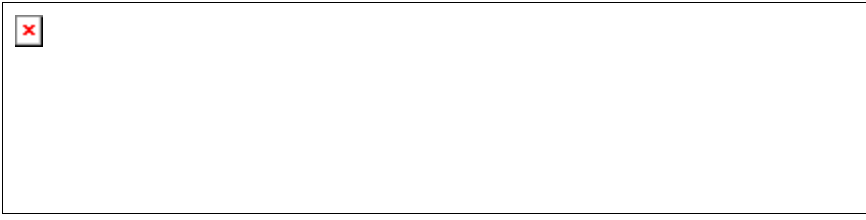
I hope I haven't missed an important detail along the way???
