To whom it may concern

I am writing on behalf of the Australian Department of Immigration and Border Protection.

I understand that Archive.org has previously published a monthly report that is produced by this Department entitled "Immigration Detention Statistics". It has come to our attention that the edition of this publication released by us on 31 January 2014 contained a link to underlying data that discloses the sensitive personal details of a number of people who were subject to immigration detention as at that date, including a number of people who have sought asylum in Australia. This release was inadvertent on our part, representing as it does a breach of the privacy of the individuals concerned. Publication of the underlying data has the potential to adversely affect the interests of those concerned and their families.

In the light of the nature of the data, I therefore request that Archive.org refrain from publishing the personal information contained within the dataset.
