Canstruct note this type of behaviour amongst youth is considered developmentally normal; however, they are planning to hold education sessions separately with female and male youth groups as a preventative measure. At approximately 22:23 NLT on 01FEB2018, Wilson Security Control Room Operator (CRO) s. 22(1)(a)(ii) received a phone call from Canstruct International (CSI) Child and Family Co-ordinator s. 22(1)(a)(ii) informing that s. 47F(1) would be emailing through a Major Incident Report of Assault – Sexual involving a Minor resident after receiving information that raised suspicion of a sexual assault incident. CSI CAF Co-ordinators s. 22(1)(a) stated to CRO s. 22(1)(a) that s. 47F(1) had been informed of rumours suggesting that Refugee s. 47F(1)

CSI CAF Co-ordinator s. 22(1)(a)(ii) completed a file review and determined there was reasonable information to raise suspicion of a sexual assault incident. The Incident Report submitted to CRO s. 22(1)(a)(ii) contained the following information. "At approximately 19:14hrs on 01FEB2018, Canstruct International (CSI) Child and Family Co-ordinator (CAFC) s. 22(1)(a)(ii) received a phone call from Community Services Manager (CSM) s. 22(1)(a)(ii) who advised that s. 47F(1) has received information from three (3) different people over the past two (2) days, who have stated that s. 47F(1)

however should be submitted as an incident report. s. 22(1)(a)(ii) requested that CSM s. 22(1)(a) complete an incident report regarding this matter

as soon as possible. s22(1)(a)(ii) then informed CSI Specialist Support Manager (SSM) s22(1)(a)(ii) and CSI Deputy Operations Manager (DOM) s22(1)(a)(ii) of the concerns. At approximately 19:45 NLT, s22(1)(a)(ii) contacted Wilson Security s47E(d) s22(1)(a)(ii) and requested that s. 47F(1) be placed on a s. 47E(d) to ensure the safety of s. 47F(1) whilst further information is gathered. At approximately 21:20 NLT, CAFC s22(1)(a) completed a file review regarding s. 47F(1) s22(1)(a)(ii) noted concerns regarding previous information report number 377731 dated 30DEC2017 and incident report number 106231 dated 30DEC2017, which raised concerns regarding s. 47F(1) and the safety of s. 47F(1). At approximately 21:31 NLT, CSI Client Services Manager (CSM) s22(1)(a)(ii) contacted Wilson s. 47E(d) s22(1)(a)(ii) and informed s. 47F(1) of the concerns of previous reports. s22(1)(a) advised that a s47E(d) would be placed on s. 47F(1) s. 47F(1). "CRO s. 22(1)(a) commenced the major notification process. CRC s22(1)(a)(ii) confirmed with Security Manager s. 22(1)(a) that s. 47F(1) had been placed on a s. 47E(d) s. 47E(d).
