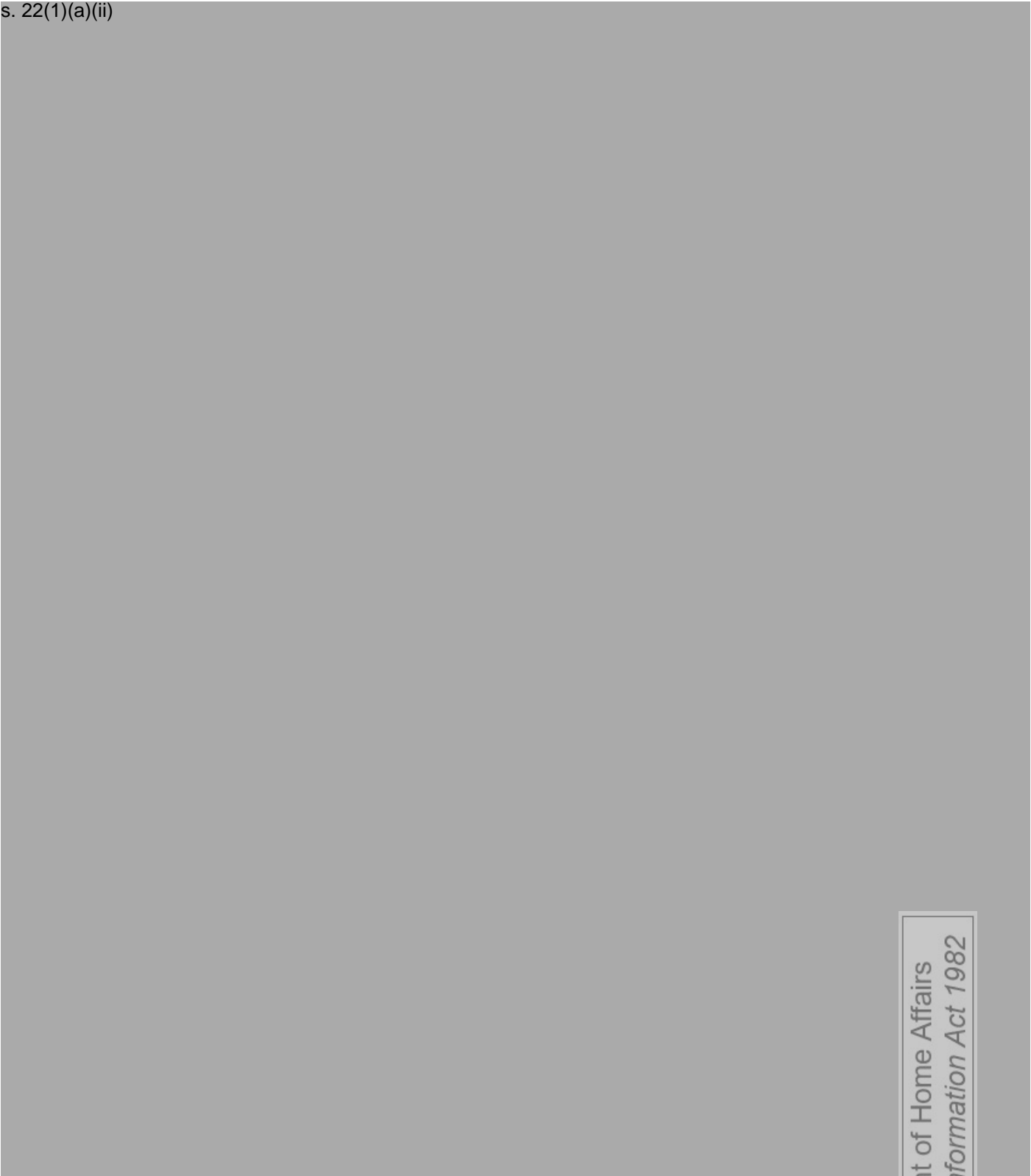

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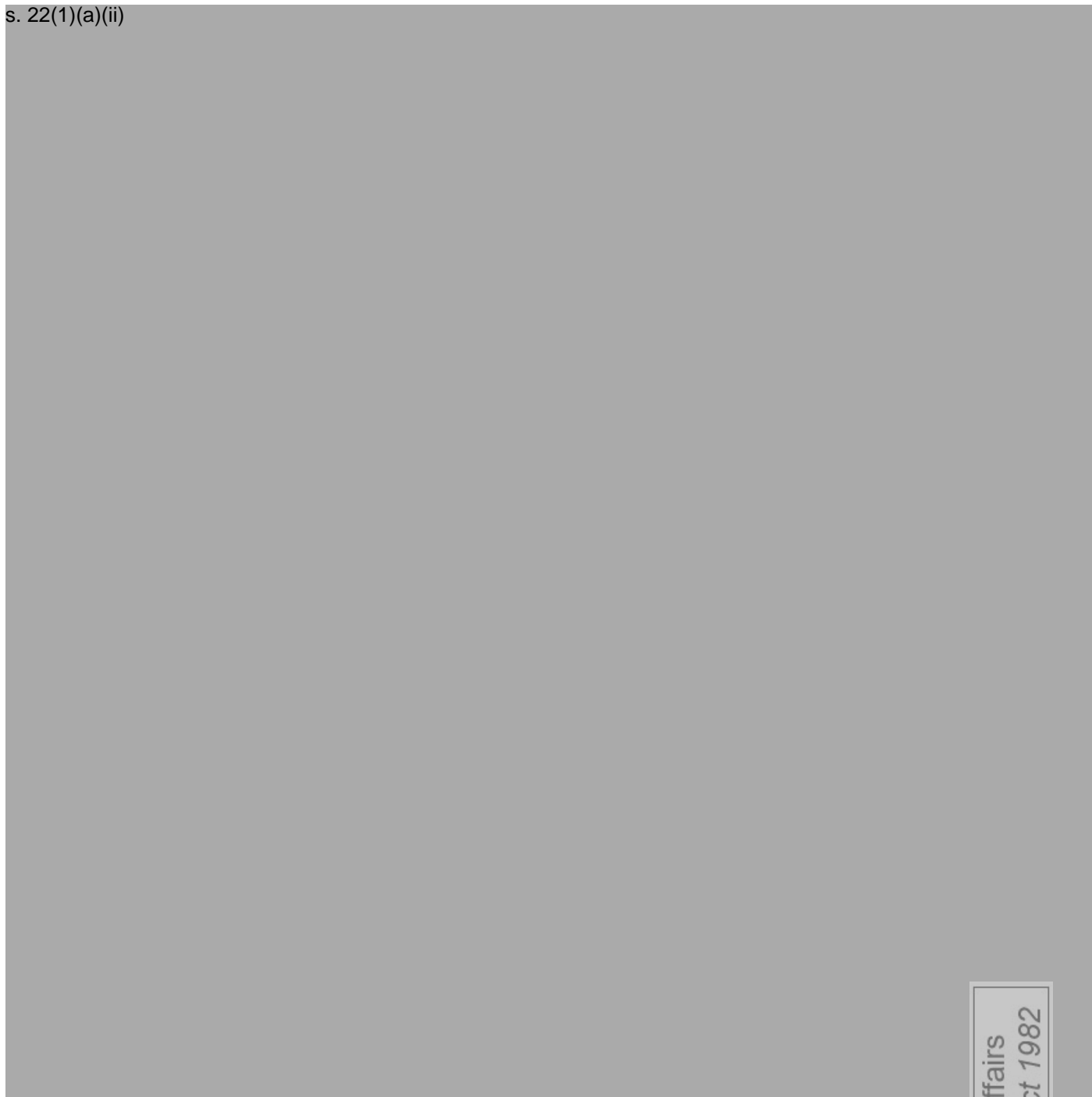

While this data is a few weeks old, at 17 November we had just under 29,000 Skilled Independent places remaining in the AIPL with 23,000 visa applications on hand. Without data to support this estimation, I would guess that we would currently have approximately 26,000 places remaining with approximately 26,000 cases on hand (including unallocated on hand).

I anticipate a further ~5000 NZ applications will be lodged in the remainder of the PY. After the next three rounds of 150 invitations for SI, we plan to discuss raising this to 300-350 per fortnightly round from mid-January in order to obtain approximately 6000 new additional points tested SI applications over the course of this PY. The invitation rate can be increased as required, but these levels should leave us with ~37,000 applications to source finalisations for this PY and still maintain a healthy on hand caseload for next PY.

The primary hurdle for program delivery for this PY is our reduced staff footprint, not the availability of cases. Higher invitations/lodgements rates without increasing staffing levels is unlikely to increase our finalisations this PY, but would impact processing times and caseload management (including complaints).

The GSM program delivery team have requested that we reduce the subclass 190 invitation rounds for three fortnights to a total of 150 for the next three rounds as they have a considerable pipeline at the moment, and we can ramp up again early next year. s. 47E(d)

The attached document shows where we are in terms of invitations for the year. We are down compared to last year but need to keep in mind the NZ caseload.

We also want to retain the subclass 489 down to 5. The AIPL for 489 is set at 1000 per year and with the backlog from 2016/17 the team is already half way so they would like to pull back and remain at 5 for as long as possible.


