### **Change to NSW application process for Form B959 - *Application for permission to move, alter or interfere with export goods under Customs control***

One of the elements of export control measures introduced last year was to include the requirement for exporters to seek permission from Customs and Border Protection to move, alter or interfere with goods for export (and no longer for export) under Customs control using Form B959.

This advice is to let you know that in NSW, applicants should now submit their completed Form B959 to Compliance Operations NSW during business hours Monday to Friday by email to:
