



Release 9.4.02 – External Notes

Purpose

This release (release 9.4.02) is scheduled for implementation on 4 February 2009 and contains several changes and incident fixes. These notes are designed to provide plain English descriptions of the changes. This will provide clients with a better understanding of what has been fixed and how it might relate to their business.

C61872 'Subject to Red line processing' message incorrectly sent when AQIS Evaluation Hold is applied on amended Import Declarations

When an Import Declaration is selected for red line processing by Customs, a response message is sent to the user with the following text:
'SUBJECT TO RED LINE PROCESSING. DOCUMENTS MUST BE SUBMITTED PURSUANT TO S71DA OF THE CUSTOMS ACT'.

This same message was incorrectly being sent when an amended Import Declaration was subject to an AQIS evaluation hold only. This led brokers / importers to submit documents to Customs unnecessarily.

A change has been made to stop this message from being included in the response message where Customs has no interest in the cargo.

C9130 Exchange Rate displaying incorrectly on Prints

Previously, exchange rates were being displayed incorrectly on amended Import Declaration prints. The exchange rate showed the version 1 rate. A change has been implemented to ensure that the exchange rate is correct for the amended version.

C18924 Concessional Instruments Adjustments screen

When using the print icon for the Concessional Instruments Adjustment screen the resulting print was incomplete.

This change will ensure that all records displayed on the Concessional Instruments Adjustment screen appear on the print.

C18983 SAC Communicator role incorrectly allocated

Previously, when a Self Assessed Clearance (SAC) was lodged on behalf of a registered client, the SAC Communicator role was incorrectly allocated. When this occurred, the broker was prevented from viewing most of the client's information tabs and add/amend roles.

A change has been made to stop the role of SAC Communicator attaching automatically when a SAC has been entered on behalf of a registered client. This change enables the broker to view other client information and add or amend roles when required without Customs intervention.

C15721 Record Count on Cargo List screens

Previously on various cargo list screens, the records displayed did not reflect the total number of records for the query. Only the records displayed on the page being viewed were being counted.

Now, the total number of records retrieved for the query will be displayed on each results page.

C59100 Sea Cargo – CLEAR status generated for containers not on Ocean Bill.

For FCL cargo type only, where a House Bill quotes a container that is not reported on the Ocean Bill, the container will have a 'HELD' status even if all other conditions have been met.

Where a House Bill quotes a container that does not exist on an Ocean Bill the status condition in the 'Import Document Status Detail View' screen will be 'Quoted Master/Ocean Bill exists 'NO'.

In this circumstance the forwarder must have the Shipping Company correctly report the container on the Ocean Bill.
