INTENTION TO REVOKE TARIFF CONCESSION ORDERS

The Comptroller-General of Customs intends to revoke the Tariff Concession Orders (TCOs) for the goods described in the following TABLE in accordance with s.269SD(1AA) with effect from 11 July 2018.

On 11 July 2018, the Comptroller-General of Customs' delegate formed the belief in respect of the TCOs, that if the TCOs were not in force on that day, and applications for the TCOs were made on that day, the Comptroller-General of Customs would not have made the TCOs. This is because the Comptroller General of Customs is aware that a local manufacturer exists in Australia producing substitutable goods in the ordinary course of business.
