The Chief Executive Officer's (CEO's), delegate has declared the intention, subject to s.269SD(1AB), to make an order revoking the TCO in the table below with effect from Thursday 12 March 2015. On 09 February 2015, the CEO's delegate formed the belief in respect of the TCO, that if the TCO was not in force on that day, and an application for the TCO was made on that day, the CEO would not have made the TCO.

That is because the TCOs are considered to be unnecessary. A TCO is considered to be unnecessary if the goods covered by that TCO can be imported under another, often more recent, TCO that often covers a broader range of goods.

Importers and customs brokers will not be disadvantaged by the revocation action, as TCOs will continue to apply to the same range of goods. Before attempting to use a TCO, an importer or customs broker should check the list of concessional instruments to ensure that the TCO still exists.

Interested parties are invited to provide, by close of business Wednesday 11 March 2015, written reasons why the TCOs should not be revoked.
