I, Michael Perry, a delegate of the Chief Executive Officer (CEO), declare my intention, subject to s.269SD(1AB), to make an order revoking the TCO in the table below with effect from 11 January 2011. On 11 January 2011, I formed the belief in respect of the TCO, that if the TCO was not in force on that day, and an application for the TCO was made on that day, the CEO would not have made the TCO.

That is because the TCO was made in contravention of s.269F(3)(a), to the extent that the TCO requires compliance with section 45(1) of the Australian Air Navigation Regulations. Section 45(1) of the Australian Air Navigation Regulations was repealed in 1988 prior to the TCO operative date of 20 June 1989. The inclusion of a repealed Australian Air Regulation cannot be considered a full description of goods as required under s.269F(3)(a).

Interested parties are invited to provide, by close of business Wednesday 9 February 2011, written reasons why this TCO should not be revoked. Interested parties may consider applying for a new Tariff Concession Order on the application form, B443 (updated March 2010) for the goods described below, worded in terms that do not include a repealed Australian Air Navigation Regulation. The TCO is invalid and therefore the TCO should not be used, either for refunds or entries.
