CUSTOMS ACT 1901**NOTICE OF INTENTION TO REVOKE TARIFF CONCESSION ORDERS - S269SD (1AA)**

It is intended to revoke the Tariff Concession Orders for the goods described in the following TABLE.

I, Benedict Joseph Hickey, a delegate of the Chief Executive Officer (CEO), declare my intention, subject to s.269SD(1AB), to make orders revoking each of the TCOs in the table below with effect from 27 April 2011. On 27 April 2011 I formed the belief in respect of each of these TCOs, that if the TCO were not in force on that day, and an application for the TCO was made on that day, the CEO would not have made the TCO.

That is because I believe that each of the TCOs were made in contravention of s.269SJ(1)(b), that is a TCO must not be made in respect of goods declared by the regulations to be goods to which a TCO should not extend. Customs regulation 185, known as the Excluded Goods Schedule, is the regulation that prevents the making of a TCO for the goods listed below.

Interested parties are invited to provide, by close of business 8 June 2011, written reasons why any of these TCOs should not be revoked.

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO REVOKE TARIFF CONCESSION ORDERS - S269SD (1AA)

It is intended to revoke the Tariff Concession Orders for the goods described in the following TABLE.

I, Benedict Joseph Hickey, a delegate of the Chief Executive Officer (CEO), declare my intention, subject to s.269SD(1AB), to make orders revoking each of the TCOs in the table below with effect from 27 April 2011. On 27 April 2011 I formed the belief in respect of each of these TCOs, that if the TCO were not in force on that day, and an application for the TCO was made on that day, the CEO would not have made the TCO.

That is because I believe that each of the TCOs were made in contravention of s.269SJ(1)(b), that is a TCO must not be made in respect of goods declared by the regulations to be goods to which a TCO should not extend. Customs regulation 185, known as the Excluded Goods Schedule, is the regulation that prevents the making of TCOs for the goods listed below.

Interested parties are invited to provide, by close of business 8 June 2011, written reasons why any of these TCOs should not be revoked.

Interested parties may consider applying for new Tariff Concession Orders on the application form, B443 for the goods described below, if they are worded in terms that do not conflict with the Excluded Goods Schedule. Any applications for TCOs keyed to tariff heading 8708 must be worded so as not to allow parts and accessories for the original equipment manufacture of motor vehicles having a gross weight of not more than 3.5 tonnes. Any applications for TCOs keyed to 9405.10.00, 9405.20.00, 9405.40.00, 9405.50 and 9405.99.00 must be worded so as not to allow goods or parts that are of ceramic.
