**CUSTOMS ACT 1901****INTENTION TO REVOKE A TARIFF CONCESSION ORDER**

It is intended to revoke the Tariff Concession Order for the goods described in the following TABLE.

I, Michael Perry, a delegate of the Chief Executive Officer(CEO), declare my intention, subject to s.269SD(1AB), to make an order revoking the TCO in the table below with effect from 23 May 2011. On 23 May 2011, I formed the belief in respect of the TCO, that if the TCO was not in force on that day, and an application for the TCO was made on that day, the CEO would not have made the TCO.

That is because the TCO was made in contravention of s.269P(4)(a), to the extent that the TCO must include only one Customs tariff classification that applies to the goods. As a result of a Tariff Advice Review, it was identified that the goods can not be classified to a single tariff classification. The TCO describes multiple types of filters, including:

- Textile filters of 5911.90.10;
- Paper filters of 4812.00.00;
- Activated carbon filters of 6810.10.00; and
- Composite filters of 8421.39.00.

The Tariff Advice Review found that the TCO specifically describes goods (activated carbon filters) that can not be classified to the tariff classification (8421.39.00) attached to this TCO.

Interested parties are invited to provide, by close of business Wednesday 22 June 2011, written reasons why this TCO should not be revoked. Interested parties may consider applying for a new Tariff Concession Order on the application form, B443 (updated March 2010) for the goods described below, worded in terms that have only one tariff classification.
