Enhanced Project By law Scheme (EPBS)

AusIndustry Determination information changes

From 1 July 2011 changes will be made to the notification of AusIndustry Determinations issued under EPBS. More information about projects receiving an AusIndustry determination will be published in the Tariff Concession Gazette as a requirement under S273(B)2 of the Customs Act 1901.

This change accords with the Australian Customs and Border Protection Service advice that 'conditions' associated with the issue of an EPBS determination must be published in order to fulfil obligations under S273B(2) of the *Customs Act 1901* relating to the making of AusIndustry Determinations.

Publishing this information will increase transparency, and complement earlier EPBS guideline changes, by providing public notice of conditions associated with an AusIndustry Determination.

Information that will be published from 1 July 2011 will relate to any AusIndustry Determination issued on or after that date and will include:

- name of your EPBS project;
- your company name;
- name of your proposed importer(s);
- detailed description of the goods for which the concession has been granted; and
- any exclusions that apply (including standard and specific exclusions).

EPBS project proponents and relevant industry stakeholders have been advised of the details of this new requirement. It has been agreed that the new expanded gazettal notifications will appear in all Tariff Concession Gazettes published on or after 6 July 2011
