CUSTOMS ACT 1901**INTENTION TO REVOKE TARIFF CONCESSION ORDERS**

It is intended to revoke the Tariff Concession Orders for the goods described in the following TABLE.

I, Michael Perry, a delegate of the Chief Executive Officer(CEO), declare my intention, subject to s.269SD(1AB), to make orders revoking the TCOs in the table below with effect from 14 June 2012. On 14 June 2012, I formed the belief in respect of the TCO, that if the TCO was not in force on that day, and an application for the TCO was made on that day, the CEO would not have made the TCO.

That is because these TCOs were made in contravention of s.269F(3)(a), to the extent that these TCOs must contain a full description of the goods to which the application relates. It was found that the good's description was insufficient to accurately identify the TCO goods in terms of full descriptions. I am also aware of potential local manufacturers of substitutable goods.

Interested parties are invited to provide, by close of business Wednesday 18 July 2012, written reasons why these TCOs should not be revoked. Interested parties may consider applying for new Tariff Concession Orders on the application forms, B443 (updated March 2010) for the goods described below, worded in terms that contains a full description of the goods to which the application relates.
