## NOTICE OF MAKING A DETERMINATION UNDER PART XVI OF THE CUSTOMS ACT 1901

In pursuance of Section 273B of the Customs Act 1901, notice is hereby given that Determination Number 01000556 was made in relation to Item 62 in Part III of Schedule 4 to the Customs Tariff Act 1995, and subject to any conditions set out hereunder, that Determination applies to goods that are:

- (1) specified in the Table hereunder;
- (2) classified under a subheading of Schedule 3 to the Customs Tariff Act 1995, specified in Item 62 in Part III of Schedule 4 to the Customs Tariff Act 1995;
- (3) entered for home consumption not earlier than 01 Jul 2012 and not later than 30 Jun 2013 by the person specified in that Determination, as shown in Part 2; and
- (4) in total, not in excess of such quantity or such value as is specified in that Determination, as shown in Part 2.

Condition

The application of item 62 in Part III of Schedule 4 to the *Customs Tariff Act 1995* is subject to the condition that the Treatment Code that identifies item 62 is included and declared in the entry for home consumption before the goods are released from Customs' control.
