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- (a) One (1) only Subsea Gas Gathering System, consisting of the following:
 - (i) Nine (9) only Wells
- (b) But excluding:
 - (i) Manifolds;
 - (ii) Umbilicals;
 - (iii) CRA lined flowlines;
 - (iv) Risers;
 - (v) ESD Valves; and
 - (vi) Jumpers
- (c) Components of the goods specified in (a) above, including commissioning spare parts integral to the project.
