NOTICE OF DETERMINATIONS MADE UNDER PART XVI OF THE CUSTOMS ACT 1901

Under subsection 273B(2) of the Customs Act 1901, notice is hereby given of the making of determinations applying to goods of a kind specified in the table below.

Materials, consumables and construction and servicing equipment, including all fuels, oils lubricants, adhesives, filters, protective garments, tools, ladders (other than articles auxiliary to and designed to be permanently attached to eligible goods under EPBS, such as pylons, supporting structures, staircases, ladders, railings, etc.) paint, varnish and the like are ineligible under EPBS, as are spare parts used for on-going maintenance beyond the commissioning of the project.
