**NOTICE OF APPLICATIONS FOR REVIEW OF DECISIONS MADE UNDER PROVISIONS OF ADMINISTRATIVE APPEALS TRIBUNAL ACT 1975**

Applications have been lodged with the Administrative Appeals Tribunal under section 29 of the Administrative Appeals Tribunal Act 1975 for a review of the decision of the Australian Customs Service in respect of the Tariff Concession Orders for the goods described in the following TABLE.
