CUSTOMS ACT 1901**INTENTION TO REVOKE A TARIFF CONCESSION ORDER**

It is intended to revoke the Tariff Concession Order for the goods described in the following TABLE.

The Chief Executive Officer's (CEO's), delegate has declared the intention, subject to s.269SD(1AB), to make an order revoking the TCO in the table below with effect from 27 February 2014. On 27 February 2014, the CEO's delegate formed the belief in respect of the TCO, that if the TCO was not in force on that day, and an application for the TCO was made on that day, the CEO would not have made the TCO.

That is because a Tariff Policy and Advice Section review found that the goods have a tariff classification of 8443.99.00 and therefore a free rate of Customs duty.
