CUSTOMS ACT 1901**INTENTION TO REVOKE A TARIFF CONCESSION ORDER**

It is intended to revoke the Tariff Concession Order for the goods described in the following TABLE.

The Chief Executive Officer's (CEO's), delegate has declared the intention, subject to s.269SD(1AB), to make an order revoking the TCO in the table below with effect from 25 July 2014. On 25 July 2014, the CEO's delegate formed the belief in respect of the TCO, that if the TCO was not in force on that day, and an application for the TCO was made on that day, the CEO would not have made the TCO.

That is because the TCO does not contain a full description of the goods to which the TCO application relates as required by s.269F(3)(a). Also the name of the organisation approving the standard is not mentioned and the terms of the standard are not available on file and therefore compliance with this TCO cannot be verified.
