CUSTOMS ACT 1901**INTENTION TO REVOKE TARIFF CONCESSION ORDERS**

It is intended to revoke the Tariff Concession Order for the goods described in the following TABLE.

The Chief Executive Officer's (CEO's), delegate has declared the intention, subject to s.269SD(1AB), to make an order revoking the TCO in the table below with effect from Thursday 18 December 2014.
