**CUSTOMS ACT 1901****INTENTION TO REVOKE TARIFF CONCESSION ORDERS**

It is intended to revoke the Tariff Concession Orders for the goods described in the following TABLE.

I, James Buntine, a delegate of the Chief Executive Officer (CEO), declare my intention, subject to s.269SD(1AB), to make orders revoking each of the TCOs in the table below with effect from 6 September 2010. On 6 September 2010 I formed the belief in respect of each of these TCOs, that if the TCO were not in force on that day, and an application for the TCO was made on that day, the CEO would not have made the TCO.

That is because each of the TCOs were made in contravention of s.269SJ(1)(b), to the extent that they apply to goods with a gross vehicle weight of 3.5 t or less. See regulation 185, and item 39 of Schedule 2 of the Customs Regulations 1926.

Interested parties are invited to provide, by close of business Wednesday 6 October 2010, written reasons why any of these TCOs should not be revoked.

Interested parties may consider applying for new Tariff Concession Orders on the application form, B443 (updated March 2010) for the goods described below, worded in terms that would only apply to goods with gross vehicle weight exceeding 3.5 t, subject to the usual requirements for a TCO application.

In-transit provision would apply upon revocation of the TCOs, but only in respect of vehicles with gross vehicle weight exceeding 3.5t. Each of the TCOs is invalid to the extent that it could be considered to apply to vehicles with a gross vehicle weight of 3.5 t or less. Therefore the TCOs should not be used, either for refunds or entries, in relation to any vehicles with a gross vehicle weight of 3.5 t or less.
