Item 15 in Part I of Schedule 4 to the Customs Tariff Act 1995 applies, subject to the next succeeding paragraphs, to goods that are specified in Column 1 of a Part of the Table hereunder and subject to such provisos (being conditions, qualifications, exceptions or exclusions), if any, as are set out in Column 2 of that Part and opposite those goods.
4. This by-law only applies to:
  - (a) goods imported by a passenger; or
  - (b) goods imported by a member of the crew of a ship or aircraft who ordinarily lives in Australia being goods that fall within the terms of paragraph 1 of Part I of the Table below; or
  - (c) goods imported by a member of the crew of a ship or aircraft who ordinarily lives in Australia being goods that fall within the terms of paragraphs 1, 2 or 3 of Part II of the Table below provided that the member has not previously received a concession under this by-law for goods within those terms in the same calendar year (as defined by the Acts Interpretation Act 1901).
5. Subject to the next succeeding paragraph, the Table hereunder applies in relation to goods that -
  - (a) are non-commercial goods; AND
  - (b) except in respect of goods specified in Part II of the Table hereunder, are personal goods.
6. In this by-law:
  - (1) "personal goods" means goods that -
    - (a) are the arriving person's property; AND
    - (b) are suitable and are intended for the arriving person's own use;  
but does not include motor vehicles or motor vehicle parts;
  - (2) "non-commercial goods" means goods that -
    - (a) are NOT intended to be used by the arriving person for ANY commercial purpose, including sale, lease, hire or exchange; AND
    - (b) are NOT goods that have been imported in such a quantity that, having regard to their nature or durability, that quantity represents a commercial quantity;
  - (3) "family" means a husband, wife, and, if any, their child who is, or children who are, aged less than 18 years;
  - (4) "used" in relation to the expression "personally owned and used" means available for use for their intended purpose by the arriving person on a continuing basis in each country in which that person was residing on a long term basis;
  - (5) "migrant" means a person who arrives in Australia and intends forthwith to take up permanent residence in Australia; AND
    - (a) is a citizen for the purposes of the Australian Citizenship Act 1948 (as amended from time to time); or
    - (b) who will, upon entry to Australia, pursuant to the Migration Act 1958 (as amended from time to time), be the holder of a permanent entry permit or an entry visa which operates as a permanent entry permit upon entry; or
    - (c) who will, upon entry to Australia, be an exempt non-citizen for the purposes of the Migration Act 1958 (as amended from time to time);
  - (6) "accompanied baggage" means goods which:
    - (a) are carried or worn by the passenger or crew member and are available for presentation to Customs at the time of their processing through Customs; OR
    - (b) are consigned to travel on the same ship or aircraft as the arriving person as baggage under the passenger's

- ticket baggage allowance or as excess baggage, but which are loaded onto another ship or aircraft due to circumstances beyond the control of the passenger; OR
- (c) are consigned to arrive on one of a group of Australian Defence Force operated ships or aircraft carrying out the joint task of transporting passengers and their baggage,
- but does NOT include goods forwarded by post or consigned as freight by the passenger or crew member whether or not they arrive on the same ship or aircraft;
- (7) "GST" has the meaning given by section 195-1 of the A New Tax System (Goods and Services Tax) Act 1999.

(4) Goods, as follows: (a) non-motorised caravans; (b) box, boat or similar trailers, non-motorised; (c) vessels of a kind designed principally for use in sheltered waters for sport or recreation, being	(1) Only one article selected from each of the three groups (a), (b) and (c) (specified in Column 1) will be allowed per family per 3 years; (2) in each case an officer of Customs shall be satisfied that -

- vessels conforming to one of the following specifications:
- (i) boats of a kind propelled by manual or pedal power;
  - (ii) sailing boats that -
    - (a) do not exceed 1 000 kilograms unladen weight;
    - (b) do not incorporate any device for propelling the boat by power, for example an auxiliary motor; and
    - (c) are not of the deep keel type; or

    - (b) do not exceed 2.5 metres in width at any section; and

- (5) Aircraft of all types, having not more than one propulsion motor, imported by a migrant aged 18 years or older.
- (6) Machinery, plant and equipment, not being goods of a kind specified in a preceding clause, imported by a migrant aged 18 years or older.
- (a) the arriving person has come to Australia with the intention of forthwith taking up or resuming permanent residence;
  - (b) the goods have been, for the whole of the period of 12 months immediately preceding the arriving person's departure for Australia, personally owned and used overseas by the arriving person; and
  - (3) in respect of a vessel specified in group (c), security shall be given by the arriving person to and to the satisfaction of an officer of Customs that the goods will not be sold or otherwise disposed of in Australia by or on behalf of the arriving person, within 2 years after the date of its entry for home consumption.
- (1) Only one article will be allowed per family;
- (2) in each case an officer of Customs shall be satisfied that the goods have been, for the whole of the period of 6 months immediately preceding the arriving person's departure for Australia, personally owned and used overseas by the arriving person; and
- (3) security shall be given by the arriving person to and to the satisfaction of an officer of Customs that the goods will not be sold or otherwise disposed of in Australia by or on behalf of the arriving person, within 2 years after the date of their entry for home consumption.
- (1) An officer of Customs shall be satisfied that -
- (a) the goods have for the whole of the period of 12 months preceding the arriving person's departure for Australia been personally owned and used overseas by the arriving person; and

- (b) the arriving person is or will be in a position to put the goods to his or her own use.
- (2) Security shall be given by the arriving person to and to the satisfaction of an officer of Customs that -
  - (a) the goods will, for a continuous period of 2 years, be put to use in Australia by the arriving person for the purpose for which they are intended; and
  - (b) the goods will not be sold, leased, hired, mortgaged or otherwise disposed of, by or on behalf of the arriving person, before the expiration of the 2 year period referred to in sub-paragraph (a) of this proviso.
- (7) Fur apparel, personal effects, furniture and household goods, not being goods of a kind specified in a preceding clause.

PART II

- (1) Alcoholic liquors to a quantity not exceeding 1 125 ml per person.
  - (1) Applies only to goods imported by persons aged 18 years or over.
  - (2) Applies only to accompanied baggage except when imported by a migrant.
- (2) Tobacco products, as follows:
  - (a) 250 cigarettes; OR
  - (b) 250 grams of cigars or other tobacco products, other than cigarettes.
- (3) Other goods being -
  - (a) in the case of a person aged 18 years or older -
    - (i) goods, the total purchase price of which does not exceed \$400 per person; or
    - (ii) where the purchase price of the goods exceeds \$400 per person, goods, or part thereof, to a purchase price of \$400 per person.
  - (b) in any other case -
    - (i) goods, the total purchase price of which does not exceed \$200 per person; or
  - (b) in any other case -
    - (i) goods, the total purchase price of which does not exceed \$200 per person; or



- (ii) where the purchase price of the goods exceeds \$200 per person, goods, or part thereof, to a purchase price of \$200 per person.

7. For the purposes of this by-law, the "Customs Tariff Act 1995" means the Customs Tariff Act 1995, as amended or proposed to be altered.

CUSTOMS ACT 1901

CUSTOMS TARIFF ACT 1995

PART I OF SCHEDULE 4

BY-LAW NO. 0240010

I, KEN RIORDAN, delegate of the Chief Executive Officer for the purposes of section 271 of the Customs Act 1901, hereby make the by-law set out in the Schedule below.

Unless the context otherwise requires, any word or phrase used in a reference in the by-law set out in the Schedule has the same meaning as if it were used in the tariff classification in Schedule 3 to the Customs Tariff Act 1995 that applies to those goods to which that reference applies.

THE SCHEDULE

BY-LAW NO. 0240010

Item 15  
Part I of Schedule 4

1. This by-law may be cited as Customs By-law No. 0240010.
2. This by-law shall take effect on and from 19 December 2002.
3. For the purposes of this by-law "non-commercial goods" means goods that -
  - (a) are not intended to be used by the passenger, or the member of the crew, for any commercial purpose, including sale, lease, hire or exchange; and
  - (b) are not goods that have been imported in such a quantity that, having regard to their nature or durability, that quantity represents a commercial quantity.
4. Subject to paragraphs 5 and 6, item 15 in Part I of Schedule 4 to the Customs Tariff Act 1995 applies to goods imported by a passenger from overseas, or a member of the crew of a ship or aircraft arriving from overseas, when the combined duty, wine tax and GST payable but for this by-law would not exceed \$50.
5. This by-law only applies to goods that are:
  - (a) non-commercial goods; and
  - (b) declared on a form that has been approved for the purposes of regulation 41 of the Customs Regulations 1926.
6. A member of a crew cannot avail himself or herself of the concessions accorded by this by-law in conjunction (ie. on the same voyage or flight) with any other concessions granted by any other by-laws written to item 15 in Part I of Schedule 4 to the Customs Tariff Act 1995, to the extent that they relate to the importation of alcoholic liquors and tobacco products.
7. In this by-law:
  - (a) "wine tax" has the meaning given by section 33-1 of the A New Tax System (Wine Equalisation Tax) Act 1999;
  - (b) "GST" has the meaning given by section 195-1 of the A New Tax System (Goods and Services Tax) Act 1999.
8. For the purposes of this by-law, the "Customs Tariff Act 1995" means the Customs Tariff Act 1995, as amended or proposed to be altered.
