 - (j) goods for radio-telephony, radio telegraphy and paging alert devices of 8525.10.10;
 - (k) apparatus of 8525.20.00;
 - (l) digital still image video cameras of 8525.40.10;
 - (m) portable receivers for calling, alerting or paging of 8527.90.10;
 - (n) printed circuits of 8534.00.00;
 - (o) electronic integrated circuits and microassemblies of 8542;
 - (p) goods of 8544.41.30, 8544.49.30 or 8544.51.10;
 - (q) optical fibre cables of 8544.70.00;
 - (r) photocopying apparatus of 9009.
5. For the purposes of this by-law, the "Customs Tariff Act 1995" means the Customs Tariff Act 1995, as amended or proposed to be altered.
