NOTICE OF DETERMINATIONS MADE UNDER PART XVI OF THE CUSTOMS ACT 1901

1. This by-law may be cited as Customs By-Law No. 1540737.
2. This by-law shall take effect on and from 1 January 2016.
3. For the purposes of item 16 of Schedule 4 to the *Customs Tariff Act 1995*, Article 2.4 of the Korea-Australia Free Trade Agreement is prescribed.
4. In this by-law "Korea-Australia Free Trade Agreement" means the Korea-Australia Free Trade Agreement, done at Seoul, South Korea on 8 April 2014, as in force from the day this instrument is signed.
5. For the purposes of this by-law, the "*Customs Tariff Act 1995*" means the *Customs Tariff Act 1995*, as amended or proposed to be altered.
