**CUSTOMS ACT 1901****INTENTION TO REVOKE TARIFF CONCESSION ORDERS**

The Comptroller-General of Customs intends to revoke Tariff Concession Orders (TCO) for the goods described in the following TABLE in accordance with s.269SD(1AA) with effect from 29 June 2016.

On 29 June 2016, the Comptroller-General of Customs' delegate formed the belief in respect of these TCOs, that if the TCOs were not in force on that day, and applications for the TCOs were made on that day, the Comptroller-General of Customs would not have made the TCOs. The Comptroller-General of Customs would not have made these TCOs because he is aware of substitutable goods being produced in Australia in the ordinary course of business.
