CUSTOMS ACT 1901**INTENTION TO REVOKE TARIFF A CONCESSION ORDER**

The Comptroller-General of Customs intends to revoke the Tariff Concession Order (TCO) for the goods described in the following TABLE in accordance with s.269SD(1AA) with effect from 8 February 2017.

On 8 February 2017, the Comptroller-General of Customs' delegate formed the belief in respect of this TCO, that if the TCO was not in force on that day, and an application for the TCO was made on that day, the Comptroller-General of Customs would not have made the TCO. This is because the wording of the TCO contains goods that fall to multiple classifications.
