BY-LAW NO. 0618799

I, Philomena Carnell, delegate of the Chief Executive Officer for the purposes of section 271 of the Customs Act 1901, hereby make the by-law set out in the Schedule below.

In the by-law set out below, "security" means the security given (under section 42 of the Customs Act 1901) to, and to the satisfaction of, the Collector by the importer.

THE SCHEDULE

BY-LAW NO. 0618799

Item 38
Part III of Schedule 4

1. This by-law may be cited as Customs By-law No. 0618799.
2. This by-law shall take effect on and from 1 JANUARY 2007.
