- (3) entered for home consumption not earlier than 01 Jul 2007 and not later than 30 Jun 2008 by the person specified in that Determination, as shown in Part 2; and
- (4) in total, not in excess of such quantity or such value as is specified in that Determination, as shown in Part 2.
