REQUEST FOR PUBLIC COMMENT ON WHETHER CERTAIN GOODS ARE PRODUCED IN AUSTRALIA AND CAN BE SUPPLIED IN COMMERCIAL QUANTITIES IN A TIMELY MANNER

The Department of Innovation, Industry, Science and Research invites public comment on whether viscose rayon staple fibre classified within subheading 5504.10 of the *Customs Tariff Act 1995* (the Act) is manufactured in Australia and can be supplied in commercial quantities in a timely manner.

This information is sought for the purpose of considering whether the rule of origin within the Australia-United States Free Trade Agreement for yarn classified within subheading 5510.90 of the Act should be amended. Such amendment would allow the yarn to achieve originating status if manufactured from, among other ingredients, non-originating viscose rayon staple fibre of 5509.10.

Written comments should be sent to the Manager, TCF Policy Group, Department of Innovation, Industry, Science and Resources, GPO Box 9839, Canberra, ACT, 2601, by no later than 30 April 2008.

If comment alleges that viscose rayon staple fibre can be supplied by a producer in Australia in commercial quantities in a timely manner, the Department of Innovation, Industry, Science and Research will review any supporting documentation, such as a signed statement by the producer stating that it produces the fibre in Australia, including the quantities that it can supply and the time necessary to fill an order, as well as any relevant information regarding past production.
